
Zine

Materials:


Glue stick

- Colored pencils (or crayons) •
- Rubber stamps
- Stickers •
- Old magazines
- Old stamps
- Paint chips


- Linings and envelopes
- String or yarn
 - Old photos
 - Other



Instructions Step 1: Fold your sheet of paper in half. Fold it again into quarters, and then once more so that it is folded into eighths.



Step 2: Open the paper so that it is folded in half. Cut in half from the fold. When you open the paper, there should be an indentation in the center.




Step 3: Fold the paper lengthwise (along the crease in the slit). Hold the paper at each end and push the ends toward each other. The sections should fold together to form an eight-page booklet.



Step 4:

Now it's time to fill in your blank notebook and turn it into a zine. How you fill it in is up to you. You can plan or sketch the content before making it final, or just improvise. Use only the basic materials or add additional elements. If you want to stick to writing and not use images, that's fine too.

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Step 5:

And that's it! You can keep it for yourself, give the original as a gift or make copies to share with your friends. In any case, you will have made your first fanzine.



You already have the cover of your magazine or Fanzine.




